Scholarships:

Credit Union Association of the Dakotas will award ten \$500 scholarships for applicants that exemplify the credit union philosophy of "people helping people" through volunteering, community service, and leadership. Five scholarships will be awarded to a graduate who is a member of a North Dakota credit union and five to a graduate who is a member of a South Dakota credit union. Scholarships will be awarded upon the successful completion of the first semester of college.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Applicant must be a United States citizen.
2. **Applicant must have been a credit union member for at least one year.**
3. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
4. Applicant must be planning to attend a two or four year post-secondary accredited university or a technical/vocational school.
5. Credit union must be affiliated with the Credit Union Association of the Dakotas.

Application Requirements:

1. A completed copy of the Dakota Credit Unions' High School Financial Scholarship application form including:
 - List of volunteer work/job experience
 - List of extracurricular activities/organizations
 - List of accomplishments, honors, and awards received
2. A written letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, community leader, or supervisor.
3. An essay, not to exceed 500 words, on one of the following questions:
"How, through your involvement in the community/school activities, events, or volunteer efforts, have you shown the cooperative spirit?"
OR
"What can your credit union do to continue providing you with financial solutions for a lifetime?"

Judging Criteria:

The judging committee, consisting of credit union professionals from each state, will score each applicant on the following criteria:

1. Volunteer work/job experience
2. Extracurricular activities/organizations
3. Accomplishments, honors, and awards
4. Essay
